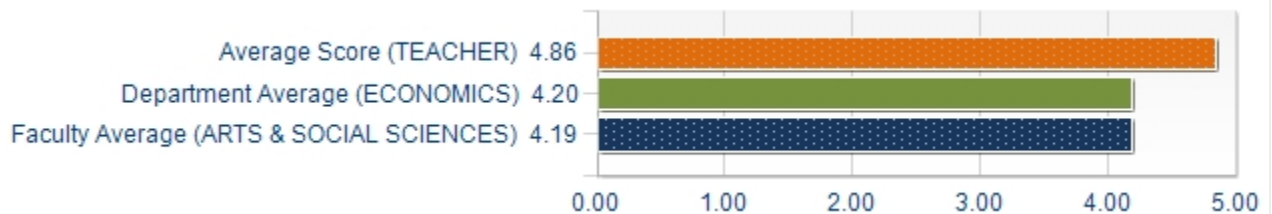

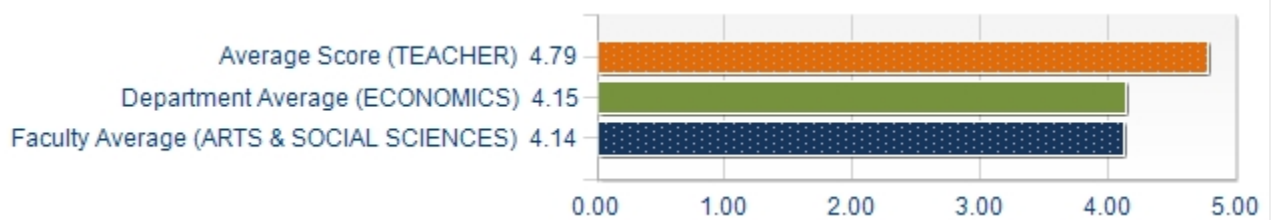

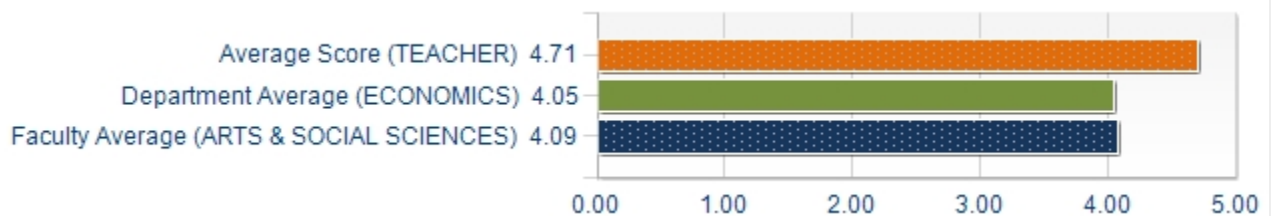

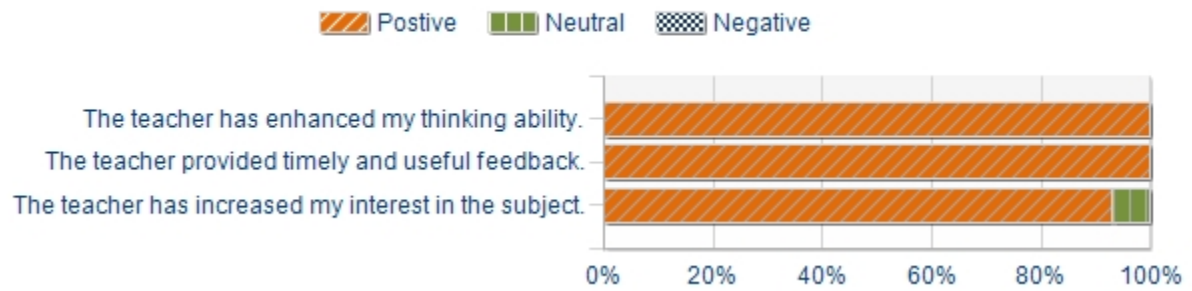

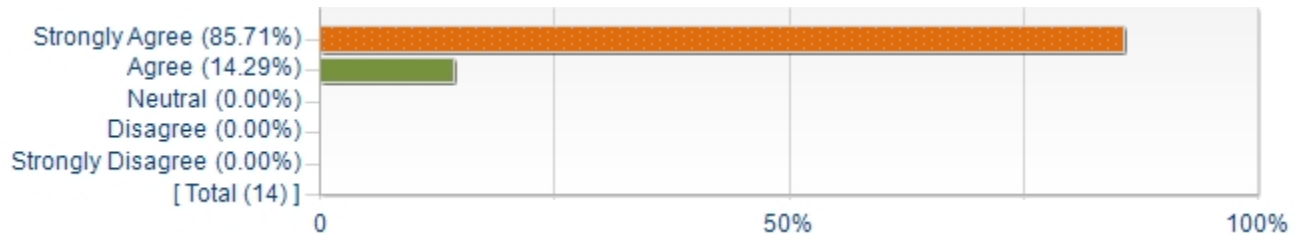

(ii) Teacher Rating Analysis Based on Scale Distribution



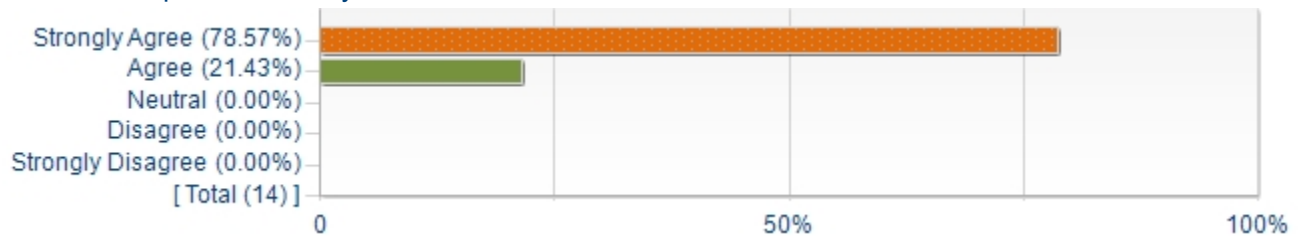

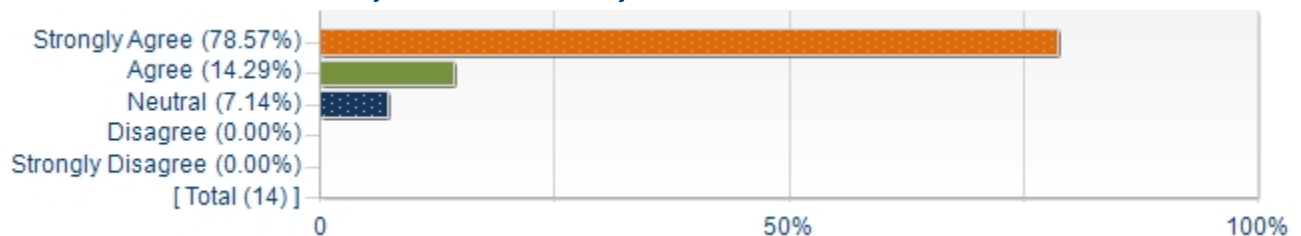
